Nashville Company Plans Feature Film of Grisham-esque Story

Nashville, August 19, 2008 – Transcendent, the feature film subsidiary of Film House, has optioned prize-winning author Mark Ethridge's novel *Grievances* to make into a feature film. Ethridge is adapting the screenplay, working with Film House CEO Curt Hahn.
